### **Article 2.2. UIAA approved Test Laboratory**

A UIAA approved test laboratory is a laboratory where testing of equipment is done in accordance with the UIAA standards for mountaineering and climbing equipment. All laboratories approved by the UIAA as in **Annex A2** are allowed to use the title "UIAA Approved". A maximum of two (2) representatives from such laboratories have a right to attend the UIAA Safety Commission Plenary meetings. An approved laboratory shall re-apply for certification at the end of its three (3) year term.
